

TOTALITY! ECLIPSE SHOW

The Houston Museum of Natural Science, with major support from NASA HEAT and ePlanetarium, created a 24-minute fulldome show for eclipse of April 8, 2024 called TOTALITY!



The show is FREE with just a format fee, and highlights what solar and lunar eclipses are and how to observe them safely. Subtitle files (English and Spanish) are included for the hearing impaired, which can easily be shown using our MediaShow display software. The subtitle text files can be easily translated into other languages.

Portions of the show are being combined with images from the eclipse and also the recent May 11, 2024 solar storm into a new show entitled SOLAR MAX - COMING SOON!

The flatscreen version of TOTALITY! has no fee for K-12 schools without a planetarium; all formats are free for Discovery Dome customers.




